### **Surveillance and prevention of communicable diseases (excluding immunisations)**

- Prevent the occurrence or manifestation of environment-related or communicable diseases by liaising with Primary Health Care, Waste Management, City Planning and Cemetery Services.
- Investigate all complaints related to environmental health report on them.
- Obtain samples for analysis and take remedial and preventative action.
- Health promotion and training programmes equipping the community with knowledge and Information.

### **Environmental pollution control:**

**Water Quality Management** - Monitor the quality and availability of water intended for human consumption, and for recreational, commercial and industrial use using the National water Act, Water Services Act and related regulations and Sans 241.

**Air quality management** - by identifying, investigating and monitoring pollution sources, and instituting remedial or preventative measures

**Noise management** – monitor noise sources and apply remedial actions.

**Waste management** – monitoring landfill sites and applying the waste management act on local municipalities, Assisting a Waste management officer at a district level to coordinate support to the local municipal waste managers and officers, Education and training of the waste pickers and applying the Environmental management Act and related regulations.

**Food safety management** - Ensuring that food is handled in a hygienic manner during production, storage, processing, distribution and sales. All food should be safe, wholesome and fit for human consumption and should conform to safety, nutritional and quality requirements; and be accurately labelled as required by law.

The functions included:

- Evaluating food premises and food transportation vehicles, and issuing certificates of acceptability to compliant premises.
- Monitoring compliance with legal requirements, and instituting remedial and preventative measures where applicable.
- Examining, sampling and analyzing foodstuffs and examining food labels.
- Presenting workshops and educating people in both the formal and informal food sectors on food safety.

**Vector control** - identify and apply remedial or preventative measures to eradicate the vectors, for instance by spraying, baiting, fumigation or the application of environmentally friendly pesticides.

**Disposal of the dead** by monitoring of funeral undertakers, mortuaries, embalmers, crematoriums, graves and cemeteries for compliance, and managing, controlling and monitoring exhumations and the reburial or disposal of human remains.

**Chemical safety** by identifying, monitoring, evaluating and preventing the use of chemicals that are harmful to human health.

**Occupational Health and Safety** - Being a member of health and safety committee ,Attending monthly meetings , Doing presentations on health and safety e.g. safety in the kitchen, safety when working with hazardous waste. Conducting daily inspection and identifying hazardous conditions and reporting on them. Making recommendations to eliminate or remedy the existing hazard. Monitoring the correct usage and storage of chemicals, monitoring the usage of PPE by staff as well as the condition of the PPE that they are using
